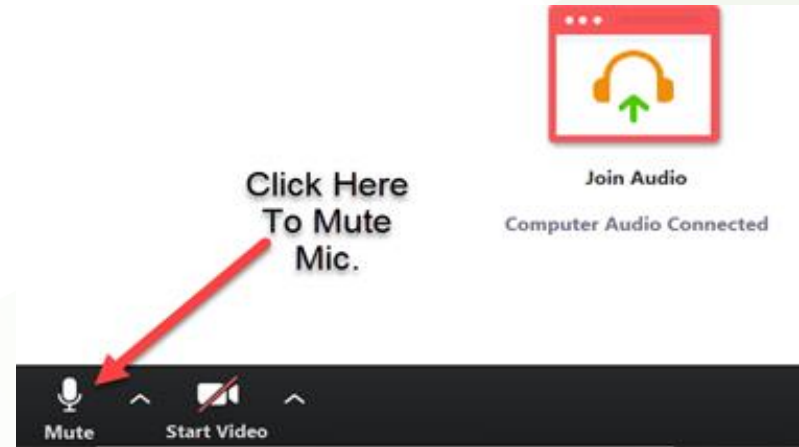


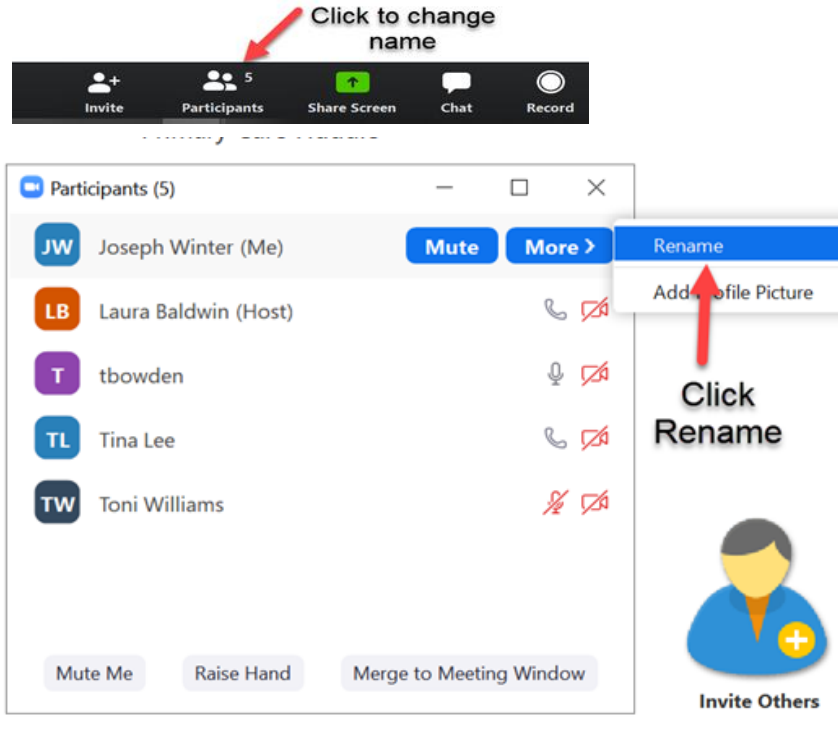

TCCN Contracting Update

- CareSource
- Anthem

Peach State Update

- March
 - Planning meetings held every 7-10 days with Peach State implementation manager
 - KHF practices proactively filled out rosters to assure correct data in place prior to May 1 - 4/1/2021 amended contract signed
- April
 - Peach State decided practice roster sheets provided were too much to utilize prior to May 1 go-live
 - Peach State used a combination of previously submitted electronic data from WellCare & Peach State to build the KHF profile
 - KHF requested summary of changed profiles to assure correct before go-live
 - PSHP indicated it would be right around 5-1 before list could be provided (never has been provided)
 - Result was wide-spread corrupted KHF practice profiles in claims system
- May
 - May 1 Go-Live/WellCare-Peach State merger
 - Requested again full roster report be submitted to KHF in early May.
 - Claims began processing wrong
 - Meeting held with PSHP to get roster
 - PSHP provided list of KHF practice tax ID #'s. which was essentially 50% wrong practices and info
 - Meeting held with 3 different departments on a call, where action items were given that included roster and claim issues.
- Tom has escalated issues to a Director with Peach State and will go to the COO next week if he is not satisfied with the outcome.

UHC Contract Negotiations

Liz Hogan

- **Incorrect Inflatons implemented**
 - Correct Fee schedule went into effect June 1, 2021
 - Underpayment is being calculated and to be implemented in the new contract.
- **Contract negotiations**
 - Rate proposal in process
 - Effective 11/1/2021, if they extent the 10/15/2021

Aetna Negotiations

- Aetna amendment needs to be in place by 11/1/2021.
 - Historically COLA updates annually for the last 3 years because we were based on a 2011 Fixed year
 - Move to more current year
- Rate increase
- COLA updates each year

- **Aetna Whole Health**
 - In negotiations
- Aetna is requesting affiliation status with Emory and/or Northside.
- Provider Relations will be sending out a survey to get the most up to date admitting rights information from the network.

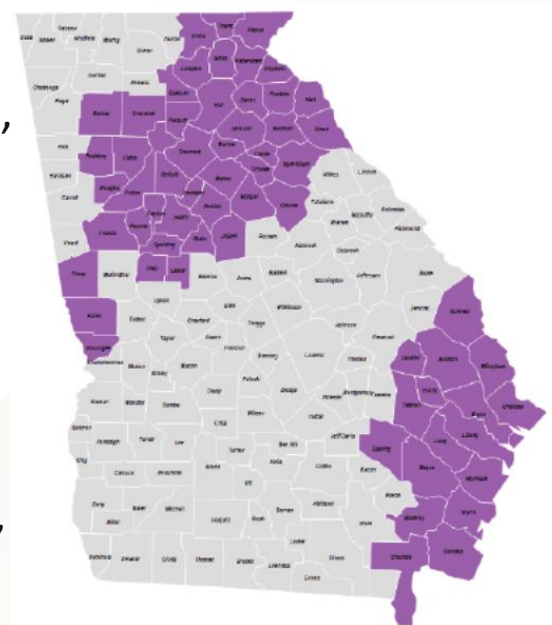

Immunizations for Adolescents – Combo 1	90 th Percentile	\$2.50 PMPM	68.71%	89.54%
Asthma Medication Ratio	75 th Percentile	\$2.25 PMPM	89.06%	68.52%

- Only applied to “actively engaged members” – 1 claim in 15 months
- **Member months = 89,687 x \$2.25 = \$201,796**
- Board voted to return 100% to practices
- Awaiting on the PMPM report from CareSource to dispense

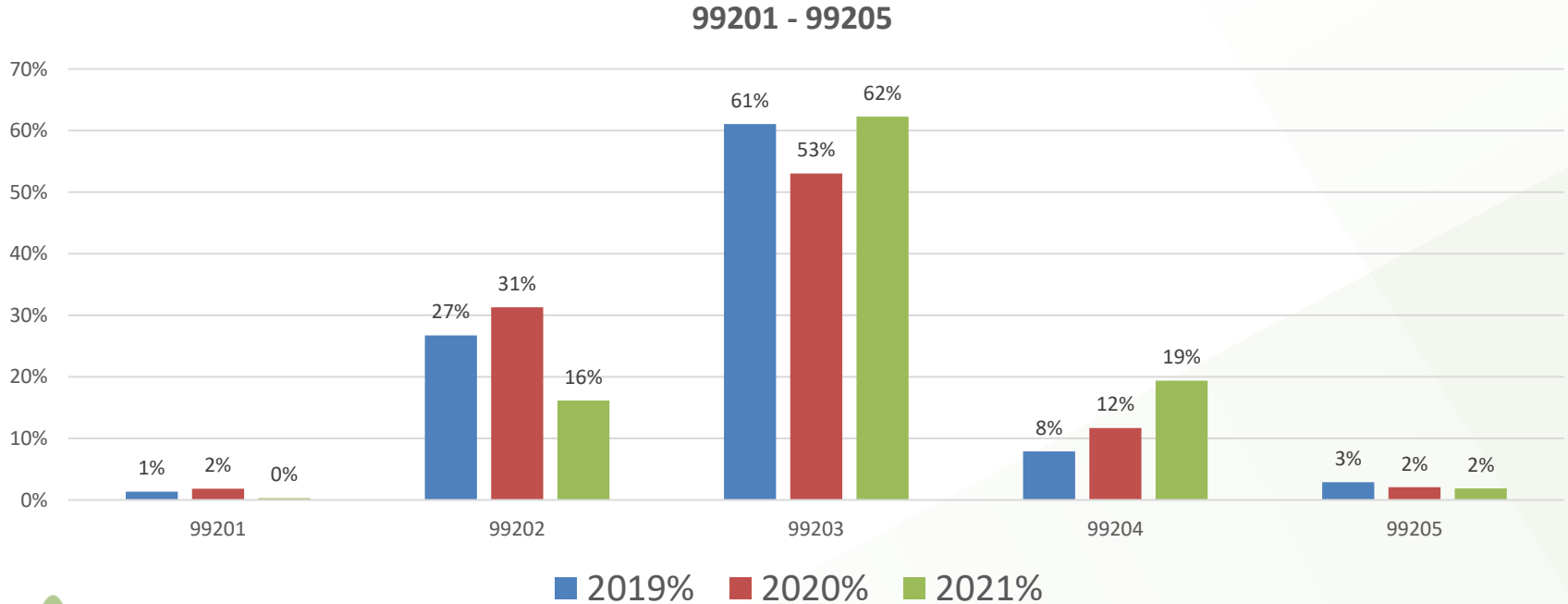

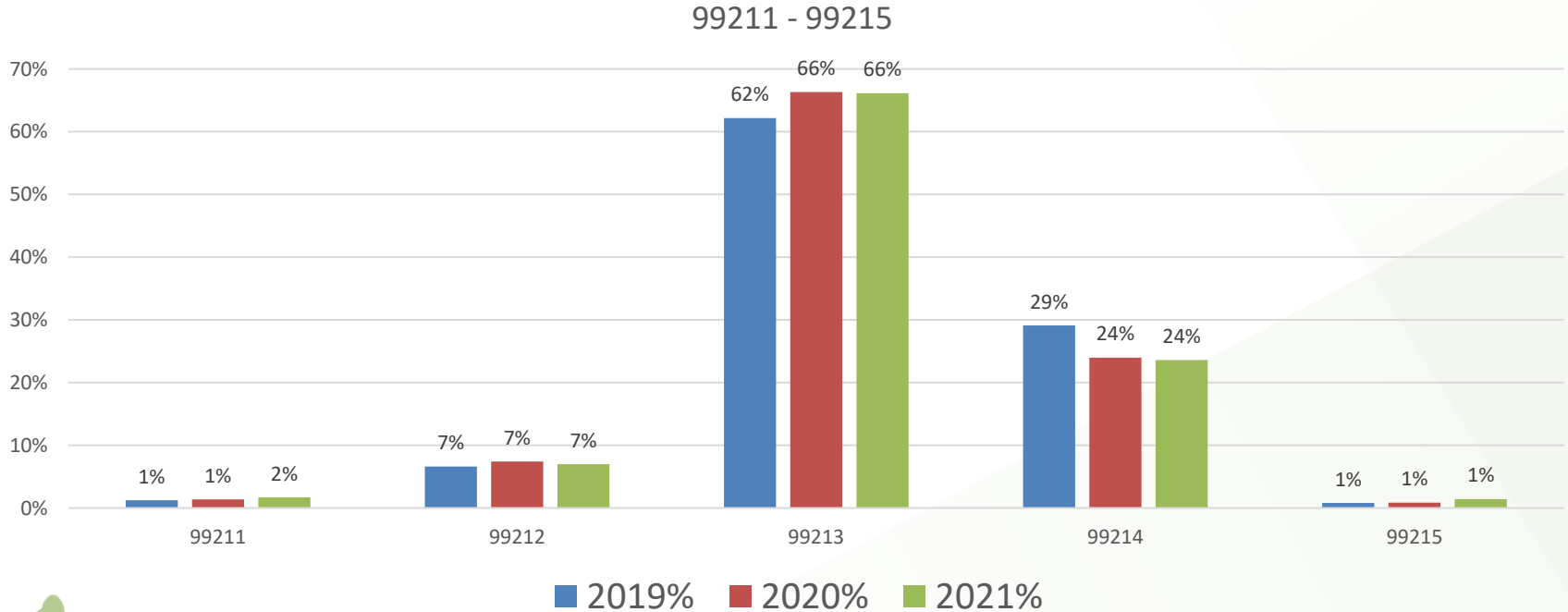

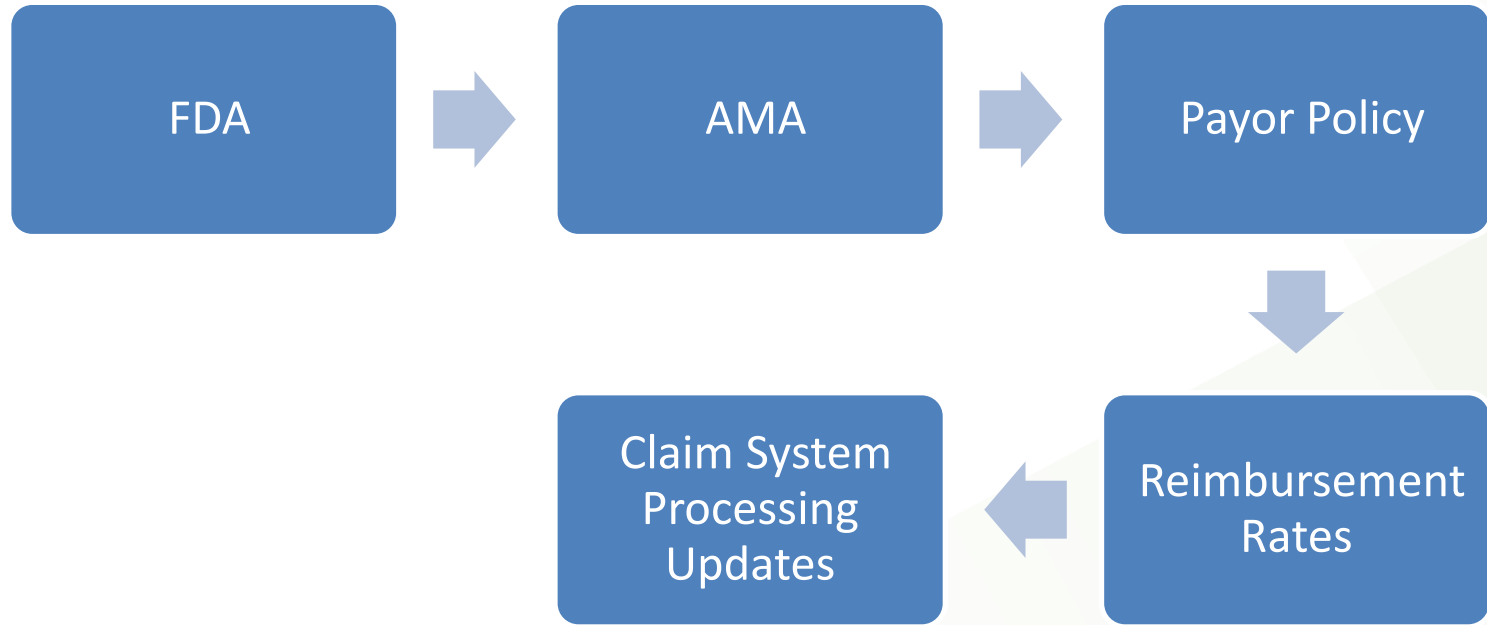

- PR Manager sent exhibit to legal for correction, error was on their end

- Reimbursement effective dates may differ with each payor.
- Lag between when the AMA approved the code, when the payor sets their reimbursement policies and when the claim systems are updated.

Payor Updates

- UHC
 - United Healthcare has been reimbursing below the \$40 base rate set by CMS for COVID vaccine administration codes.
***\$52.45** per dose for all claims with dates of service **July 1, 2021**, onwards.
 - **90619** - Meningococcal (Groups A, C, Y, W) Conjugate Vaccine, commonly referred to as MedQuadfi™ and **90697** Diphtheria and Tetanus Toxoids and Acellular Pertussis, Inactivated Poliovirus, Haemophilus b Conjugate and Hepatitis B Vaccine Suspension, commonly referred to as Vaxelis™
 - *United Healthcare has set reimbursement rates for these codes as of **July 1, 2021**. Prior to these dates, UHC did not have a set rate for these CPT codes and claims may have been denied.
- Aetna
 - 90619/90697 not processing correctly
- Humana
 - Not paying competitive rates for 90619 and 90697
- Cigna
 - Paying below the \$40.00 base rate for COVID vaccinations

Q & A for Parents: COVID-19 Vaccine for Children Ages 12 years old and older.

May 18, 2021

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends that children 12 years of age and older be vaccinated against COVID-19. Their policy statement comes after the recent emergency authorization by the U.S. Federal Drug Administration of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine for adolescents 12 years of age and older. The FDA authorization was followed by discussion with the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, which included a review of data provided by clinical trials.

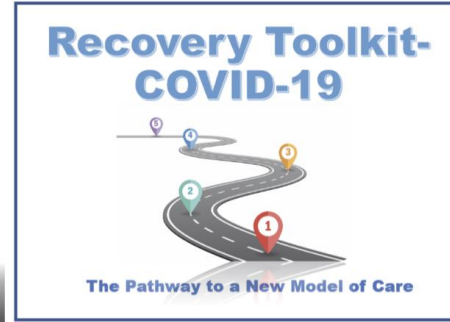
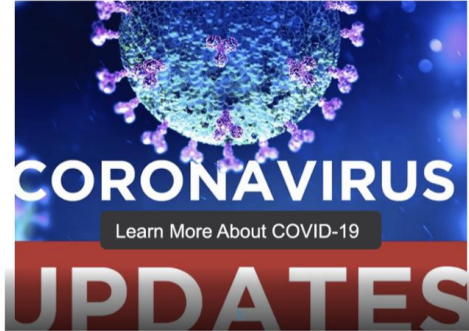

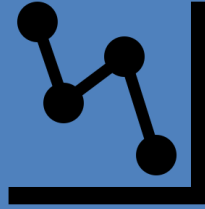
